Additionally, the Personal Representative must publish a Notice to Creditors for two consecutive weeks advising any unknown creditors that they have three months from the date of the first publication within which to file claims against the Estate. The Personal Representative must also send the Notice to Creditors to all known and reasonably ascertainable creditors, who also have three months from the first publication date or 30 days after the date of service of the Notice (whichever is later) to file any claims they may have against the Estate or be forever barred. The Notice to Creditors in (Name of Decedent)'s Estate was published on October 9, 2009.

The Personal Representative or any other interested person in the Estate has one month after the expiration of the claims period within which to object to any claim which may have been filed. Ordinarily, no estate assets are distributed to any beneficiary until this period has expired.

Included in the creditors' claims is the Personal Representative's Proof of Claim. This includes all of the debts of the decedent which the Personal Representative has paid or intends to pay for which no claim has been filed or for which an improper claim has been filed. The Proof of Claim of the Personal Representative is done not only to give the beneficiaries an opportunity to object to the payment of debts of the decedent, but in order to satisfy the requirements of the Internal Revenue Service with respect to deductibility of the decedent's claims. A copy of the Personal Representative's Proof of Claim being filed with the Court by (Name of Personal Representative) is enclosed.

Payment of Claims

At the end of five months from the first publication of Notice to Creditors, all unobjected to claims filed against the estate must be paid or the estate becomes liable for the payment of interest. A claimant whose claim has been objected to has thirty days within which to file an independent action to enforce the claim. Objections must be filed with the court and a copy thereof mailed to the creditor by certified or registered mail.

Estimated Closing of the Estate

Usually after all claims have been satisfied and adequate provisions made for the payment of costs and expenses of administration, steps can be taken to close the administration of the estate. As this estate will not be required to file a federal estate tax return, we will not have to wait on a closing letter from the Internal Revenue Service. Accordingly, I anticipate being able to close the estate approximately six to eight months from the issuance of the Letters of Administration or as soon as the condominium is sold.

At the conclusion of the Estate administration, we will prepare a final accounting and plan of final distribution for your review and approval.
