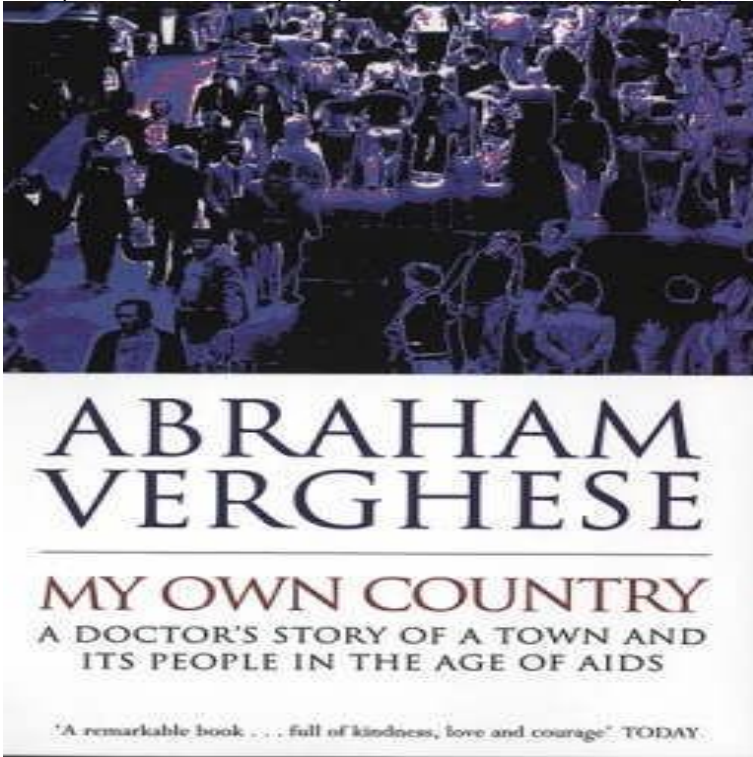


My Own Country: A Doctors Story
